Postgraduate Accrediting Diploma in Constructivist Psychotherapy

This training leads to registration as a psychotherapist with UKCP.

It extends over 5 years with attendance at four 4-day blocks for a minimum of 4 years plus on-line tutorials and group discussions. Preparatory/selection workshops will take place in London in March 2017 and the programme will start in early May.

Personal Construct Psychology model focuses on human uniqueness, approaching change through personal meaning in everyday life. The emphasis on understanding individuals within society and its cultural influences makes PCP a particularly relevant and robust theory actively challenging ethnocentric and normative ideas and practice.

PCP is eclectic in its use of tools and techniques with individuals and with groups, employing visual and performing arts as well and words and all combining to provide something else beyond the traditional 'talking cure'. Thus the therapeutic model is applicable to a wide range of client needs including complex and enduring conditions.

The overall fees cover theoretical, professional, personal experiential and research components and include all required assessments.

Applicants will have a background in health or social care, education or related fields and will be looking for an accredited professional training with opportunities for personal development.
